

I Love Horses because...Contest Rules

1. Participants must be at least 8 years of age.
2. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the entry form.
3. Contest will run with at least \$1500 worth of entries. If under \$1500 is raised, then Shalom Ranch Ministries will give the contest entrants the option to get their money back or accept a receipt for the donation. Foal will not be transported if winner is within Saskatchewan or within a 200 mile radius. The winner will be responsible for transport
4. If winner is in another location, then Shalom Ranch Ministries will pay for the foal's transportation to major cities in Canada and America.

6. SRM has the cost of foal care and transport costs to major cities in Canada or America.
7. Upon winning the foal, winner will arrange foal pickup through SRM and Keyhole Ranch. A major city will be picked and then the winner will be responsible to pick up the foal or pay an extra fee to have the foal delivered to their door.
8. All proceeds from the contest will go toward the running of the Equine Therapy ranch and is at the discretion of the Executive Director under the direction of the Board of Directors.
9. The foal chosen for the contest will be in excellent health and good conformation. The foal will be halter broke and at least 5 months old on date of transport.
10. The foal will be American Bashkir Curly register-able. These horses are hypo-allergenic. Please see www.abcregistry.com for more information.
11. Entry fee is \$50.
12. Early bird entry fee is \$45 and should be postmarked no later than 15 March 2007.
13. Contest closes 15 September 2008.
14. Winner will be announced 30 September 2008 on the website www.ShalomRanch.org. Winner will be contacted by phone.
15. Entries will be judged by how much "heart" that is put into the project. The contestants' age will be taken into consideration.
16. The entries will be judged by a panel of judges. Final decision must be approved by Executive Director of SRM.
17. Foal will go to an approved home only. An equine specialist or vet must inspect the premise or know of the premise to vouch for the suitability and safety of the foal.
18. Foal will be up to date on all required shots for transport. This includes any tests that are needed for entry into the United States.
